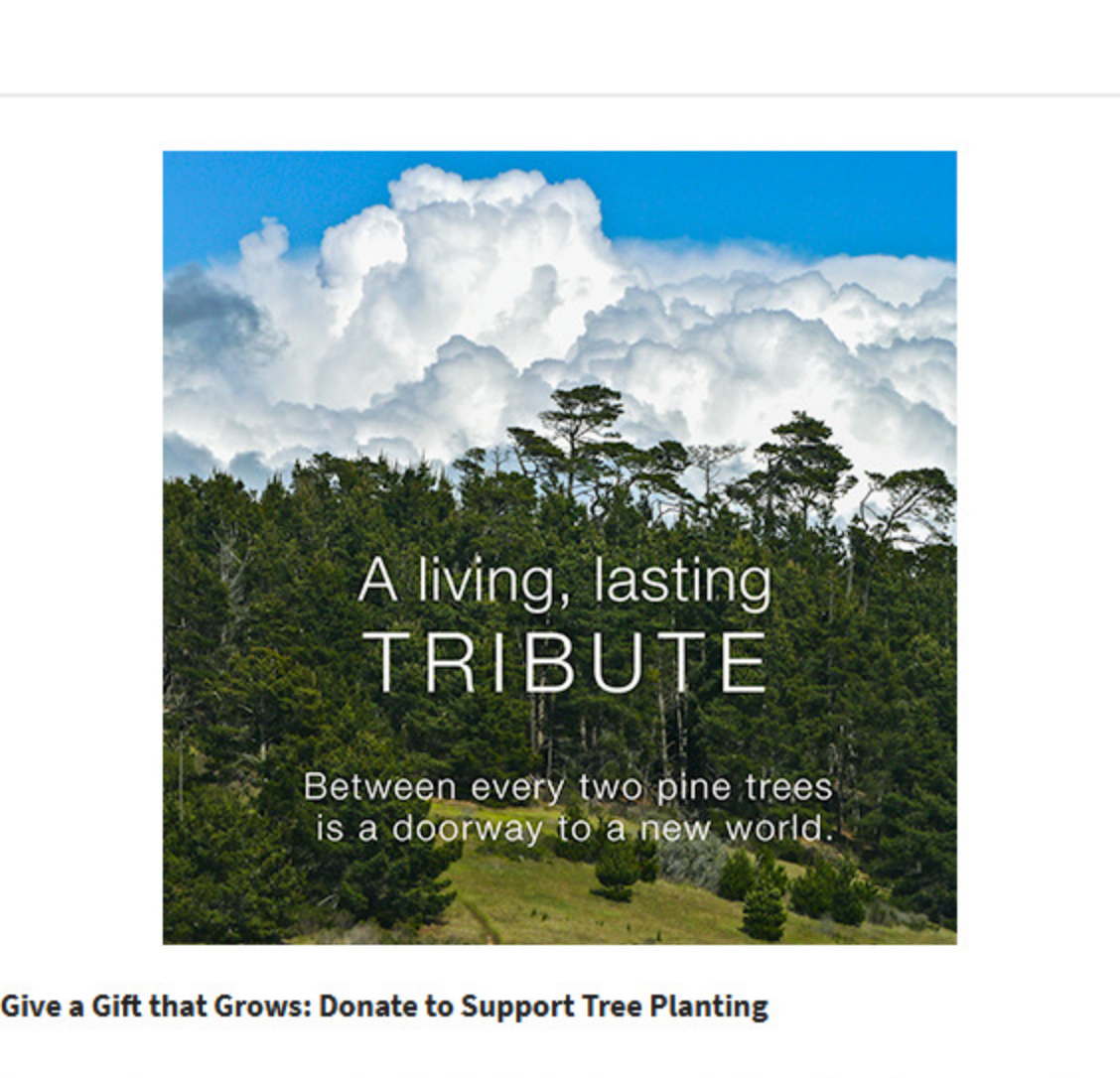

Saturday, Nov 28, 9 AM to Noon

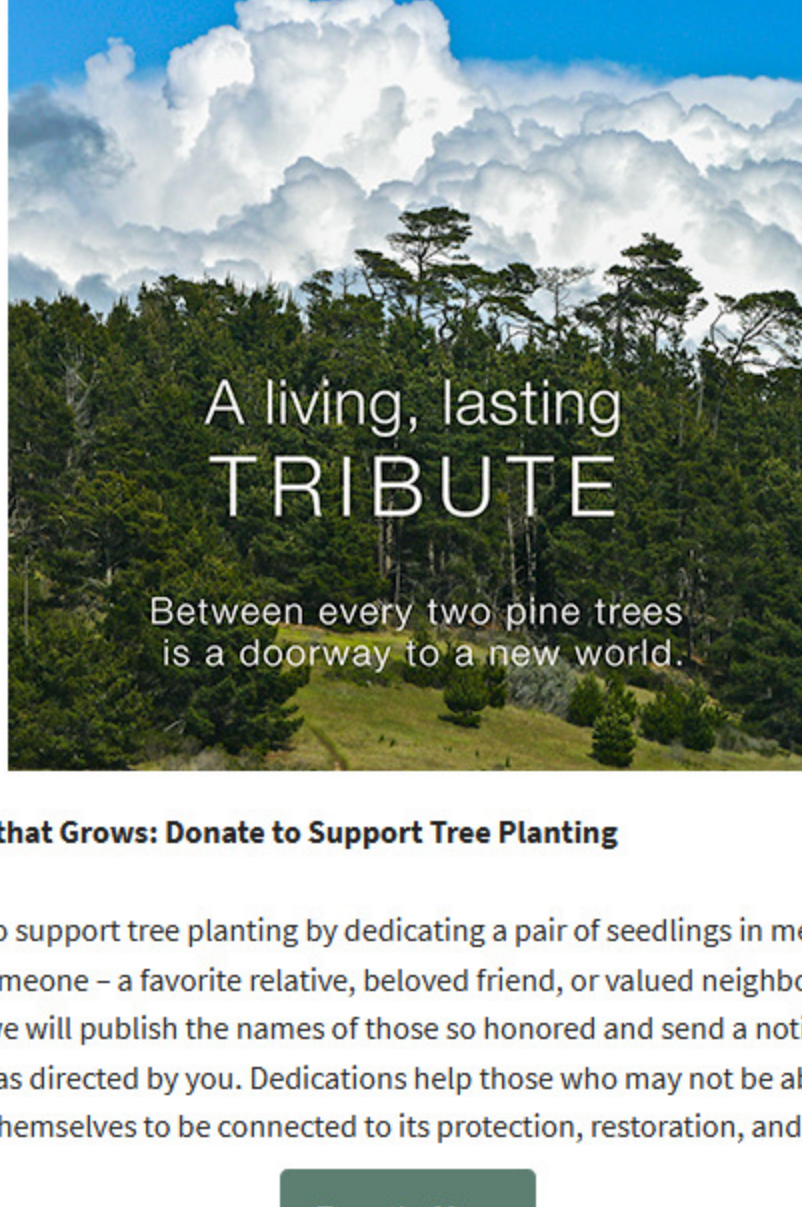


A treasured Cambria tradition is Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve's annual family-friendly tree planting on the Saturday after Thanksgiving (weather permitting). This year it will be held on Nov 28 from 9 AM to Noon.

Fiscalini Ranch Preserve is home to many natural treasures, but among the rarest is native Monterey pine forest. Caring for this forest is one of FFRP's highest priorities. With community help, we have been able to expand the forest by two-thirds over the last 20 years. GREAT JOB, EVERYONE!!!

During a time when so much is uncertain, there are few things as satisfying as seeing the seedlings you plant grow into young trees in a few short years. Become a force for nature by planting trees!

Meet at the Huntington Road entrance to the Ridge Trail. Social distancing will be observed. Wear a mask, dress in layers, wear sturdy shoes, and, if possible, bring work gloves and a shovel or trowel. Some tools and gloves will be available. No reservation required. Rain cancels the event.



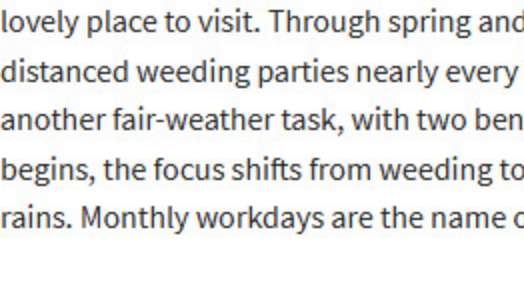
Give a Gift that Grows: Donate to Support Tree Planting

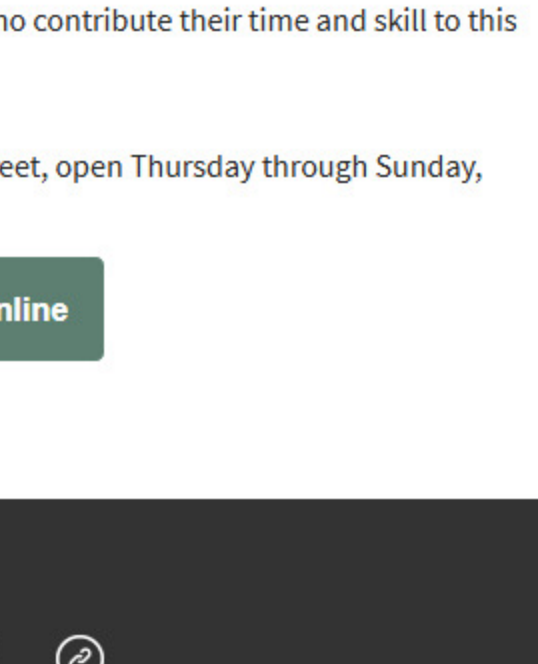
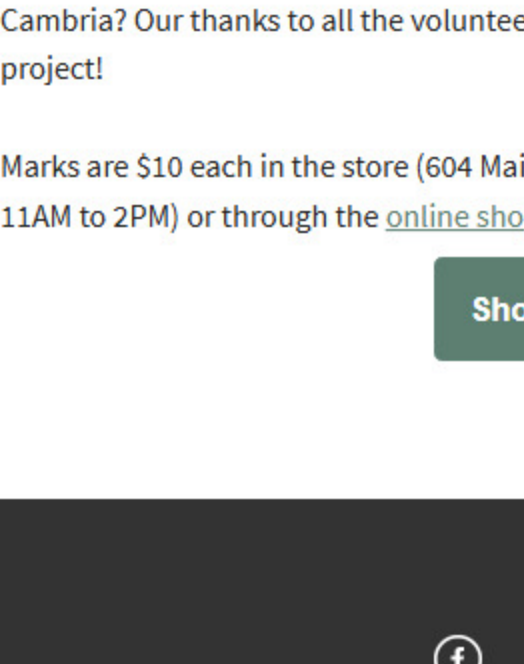
It is that ownership and stewardship that keeps the Ranch going.

Volunteer "Ranch Hands" help with the many tasks that make the Ranch such a lovely place to visit. Through spring and summer they have been holding socially-distanced weeding parties nearly every Wednesday. Bench repair and replacement is another fair-weather task, with two benches updated in 2020 (above left). As fall begins, the focus shifts from weeding to trail maintenance in anticipation of winter rains. Monthly workdays are the name of the game going forward.

Available online or in our store

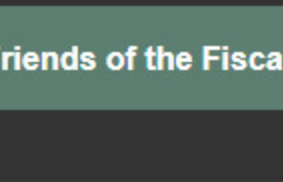


Support FFRP and wear your local pride with a poppy or pine cone face mask! Each triple-layer mask is lightweight and breathable. Two outer layers are 100% cotton with an inner layer of 95% cotton and 5% Spandex Jersey for softness. A secured nose wire even reduces fogging on glasses!
